## Expansion of restrictions across NSW

Multiple local government areas across NSW now have stay at home orders in force in response to the spread of COVID-19.

Stay at home orders apply to Greater Sydney, Armidale, Newcastle and Hunter, Northern Rivers, Tamworth, Dubbo and Western NSW.

## Rules for construction sites

<u>COVID-19 rules</u> apply for construction sites across NSW. Differing rules may apply depending on construction site locations.
