## COVID-19 - Caravan parks and camping grounds shutdown

The NSW Government has enacted the Public Health (COVID-19 Gatherings) Order (No 2) 2020 to curb the spread of the COVID-19 in NSW.

Amongst a range of new restrictions, all caravan parks and camping grounds must not be open to the public, effective from 26 March 2020.

The following exceptions to caravan parks and camping grounds applies:

- accommodating permanent residents of the caravan park or camping ground or other persons who have no other place of permanent residence, and;
- allowing visitors to visit persons noted above.

All Crown land managers (CLMs) with caravan parks and camping grounds on reserves they manage must comply with the order.

The restriction also applies to showground operators who provide caravan and/or camping accommodation. NSW Health is the lead agency responsible for the State's response to COVID-19. All CLMs should regularly check current advice, and follow guidance from NSW Health. For the most current information please visit the [NSW Health website](#).

The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (the department) acknowledges that many CLMs have concerns about the impact COVID-19 on the Crown reserves they manage.

The department will continue to update CLMs via email alerts with information and additional support in response to COVID-19.
